#### A Heavenly Promised Land

Heb. 11:8-10: 8 "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; 10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God."



#### A Heavenly Promised Land

Heb. 11:13-16: 13 "These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. 14 For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland. .... 16 But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them."



#### A Heavenly Promised Land

- Heb. 13:5b "for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU,"
- Heb 13:6 so that we confidently say, "THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?"
- Heb 13:7 Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith.
- Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

• Dt. 4:1: 1 "Now, O Israel, <u>listen</u> to the statutes and the judgments which I teach you to observe, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers is giving you."





• Dt. 4:40: 40 You shall therefore keep His statutes and His commandments which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land which the Lord your God is giving you for all time."





## **Obey Carefully**



#### Obey Carefully

- **Dt. 5:32:** <sup>32</sup> "Therefore you shall be careful to do as the Lord your God has commanded you; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left."
- Dt. 6:3: <sup>3</sup> "Therefore hear, O Israel, and be careful to observe it, that it may be well with you, and that you may multiply greatly as the LORD God of your fathers has promised you— 'a land flowing with milk and honey.'"



#### Obey...

- Carefully (Dt. 4:5-6; 5:1, 32-33; 6:1-3, 25; 8:1; 11:22-23, 32; 12:1, 32; 15:4b-5; 16:12; 17:10-11, 18-19; 24:8; 26:16; 28:1, 13-15, 58-59; 31:12; 32:44-47)
- Diligently (Dt. 4:9; 6:17; 28:1)
- Earnestly (NKJV) (Dt. 11:13-14)
  - Listen Obediently (NASB) "hearken diligently" (KJV)



#### Strictly Obey

- Don't add to or take from (Dt. 4:1-2; 12:32)
- Don't turn to right or left (Dt. 5:32; 17:11, 18-20; 28:14)
- Don't turn aside (Dt. 9:12, 16; 11:16, 26-28; 31:29)
- Just as I commanded (Dt. 24:8)



## Strictly Obey

- Don't add or subtract (Rev. 22:18-19)
- Don't preach another gospel (Gal. 1:6-10)
- Don't teach a different doctrine (1 Tim. 1:3-7; 6:3-5)
- Don't substitute the doctrines of men (Mk. 7:7, 8, 9, 13)
- Don't go beyond (2 Jn. 9-11)



## Obey All Commands



#### Obey All Commands

• **Dt. 5:33:** <sup>33</sup> "You shall walk in <u>all</u> the ways which the LORD your God has commanded you, that you may live and *that it may be* well with you, and *that* you may prolong *your* days in the land which you shall possess."



## Obey All Commands

Dt. 6:1-2: 1 "Now this is the commandment, and these are the statutes and judgments which the LORD your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe them in the land which you are crossing over to possess, 2 that you may fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson...."



#### Obey All...

- All His Ways (Dt. 5:33; 10:12-13; 11:22-23; 19:9)
- All His Commandments (Dt. 5:29, 31; 6:1-2, 24-25; 11:8-9, 22-23; 12:14; 13:17-18; 19:9; 24:8; 26:13-14; 26:18; 27:1; 28:1-2, 15; 30:8-9)
- All His Statutes (Dt. 5:31; 6:1-2, 24-25; 11:32; 17:19; 28:15)
- All His Words (Dt. 12:28; 17:19; 32:44-47; 27:26; 28:58-59; 29:29; 31:12; 32:44-47)
- All His judgments (Dt. 5:31; 11:32)





Dt. 6:4-5: <sup>4</sup> "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! <sup>5</sup> "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength."



• **Dt. 10:12-13:** <sup>12</sup> "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to **fear** the LORD your God, to **walk** in all His ways and to **love** Him, to serve the LORD your God with **all your heart** and with **all your soul**, <sup>13</sup> "and to **keep** the commandments of the LORD and His statutes which I command you today for your good?"



Dt. 26:16: <sup>16</sup> "This day the LORD your God commands you to observe these statutes and judgments; therefore you shall be careful to observe them with all your heart and with all your soul."



## Obey All Your Days



#### Obey All Your Days

Dt. 6:1-2: 1 "Now this is the commandment, and these are the statutes and judgments which the LORD your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe them in the land which you are crossing over to possess, <sup>2</sup> "that you may fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged."



### Obey All Your Days

- **Dt. 11:1:** <sup>1</sup> "Therefore you shall love the LORD your God, and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments, and His commandments always."
- **Dt. 12:1:** <sup>1</sup> "These are the statutes and judgments which you shall be careful to observe in the land which the LORD God of your fathers is giving you to possess, **all the days** that you live on the earth."



- Carefully (Dt. 5:32; 6:3)
- All Commandments (Dt. 5:29, 33; 6:2; 10:12)
- All Our Heart (Dt. 6:4-5; 10:12-13; 26:16)
- All Our Days (Dt. 4:9-10; 5:29; 6:2)





#### Obedience Is Key

- Your wisdom & your understanding (Dt. 4:5-6)
- You may live (Dt. 5:33; 8:1)
- It may be well with you (Dt. 5:33; 6:3, 18)
- You may prolong your days in the land (Dt. 5:33; 6:2; 32:47)
- You may multiply greatly (Dt. 6:3; 8:1)
- For our good (Dt. 6:24; 10:13)



#### Strict Obedience...

- Did not nullify God's grace (Dt. 4:1, 40)
- Did not negate love (Dt. 6:1-5)
- Did not mean merit (Dt. 7:6-8)
- Did not negate the essentiality of faith (Dt. 1:29-32; 9:23-24; 32:20)



#### As God Looks At Us...

Dt. 5:29: <sup>29</sup> Oh, that they had such a heart in them that they would fear Me and always keep all My commandments, that it might be well with them and with their children forever!



#### As God Looks At Us...

 Dt. 30:15 − 16 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it."



#### As God Looks At Us...

- Dt. 30:19 20 "I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live,
- 30:20 loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."
