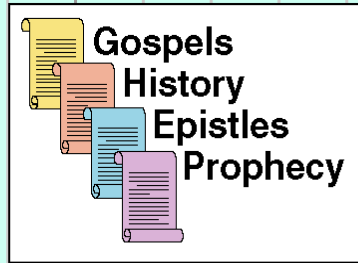
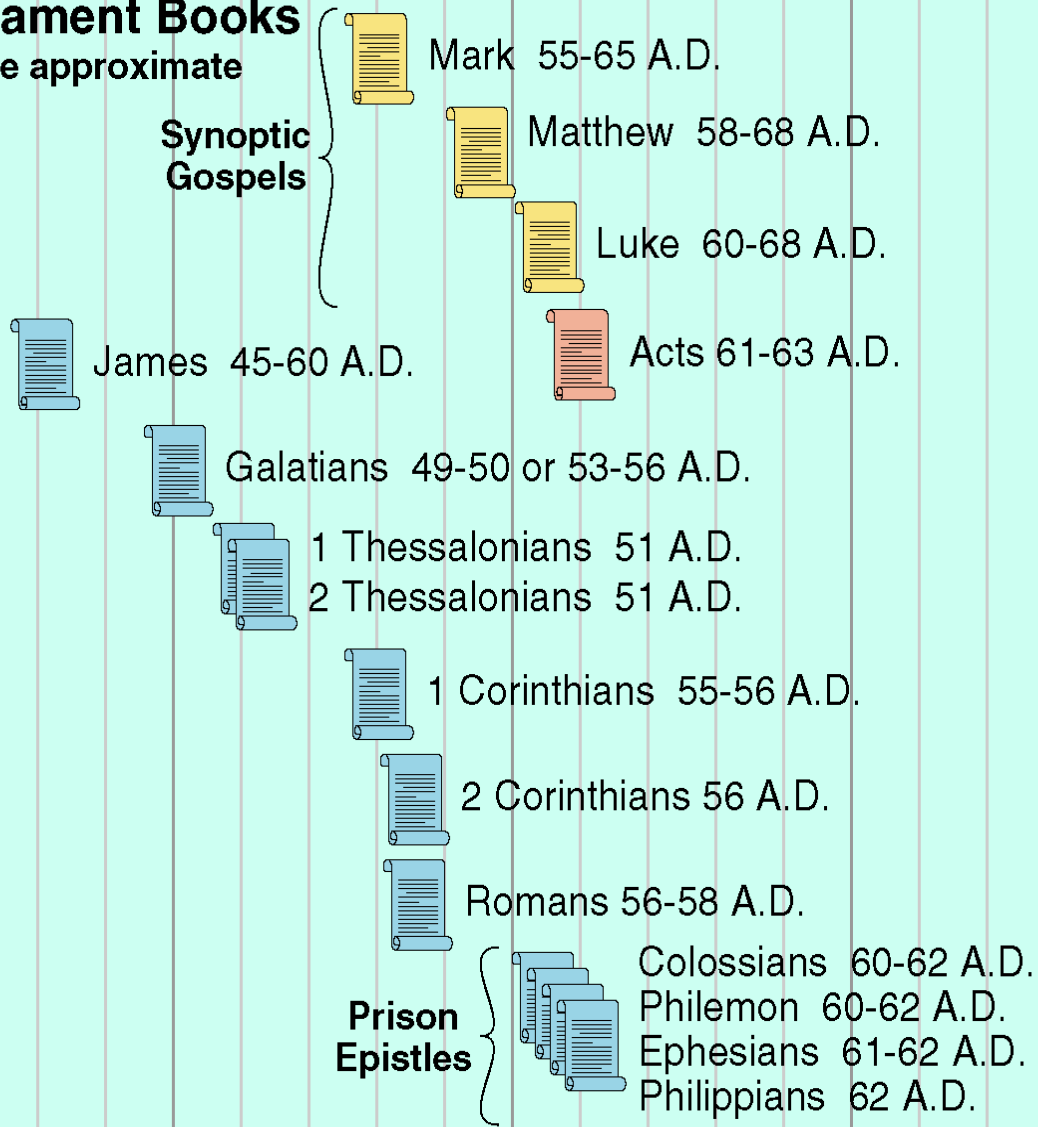

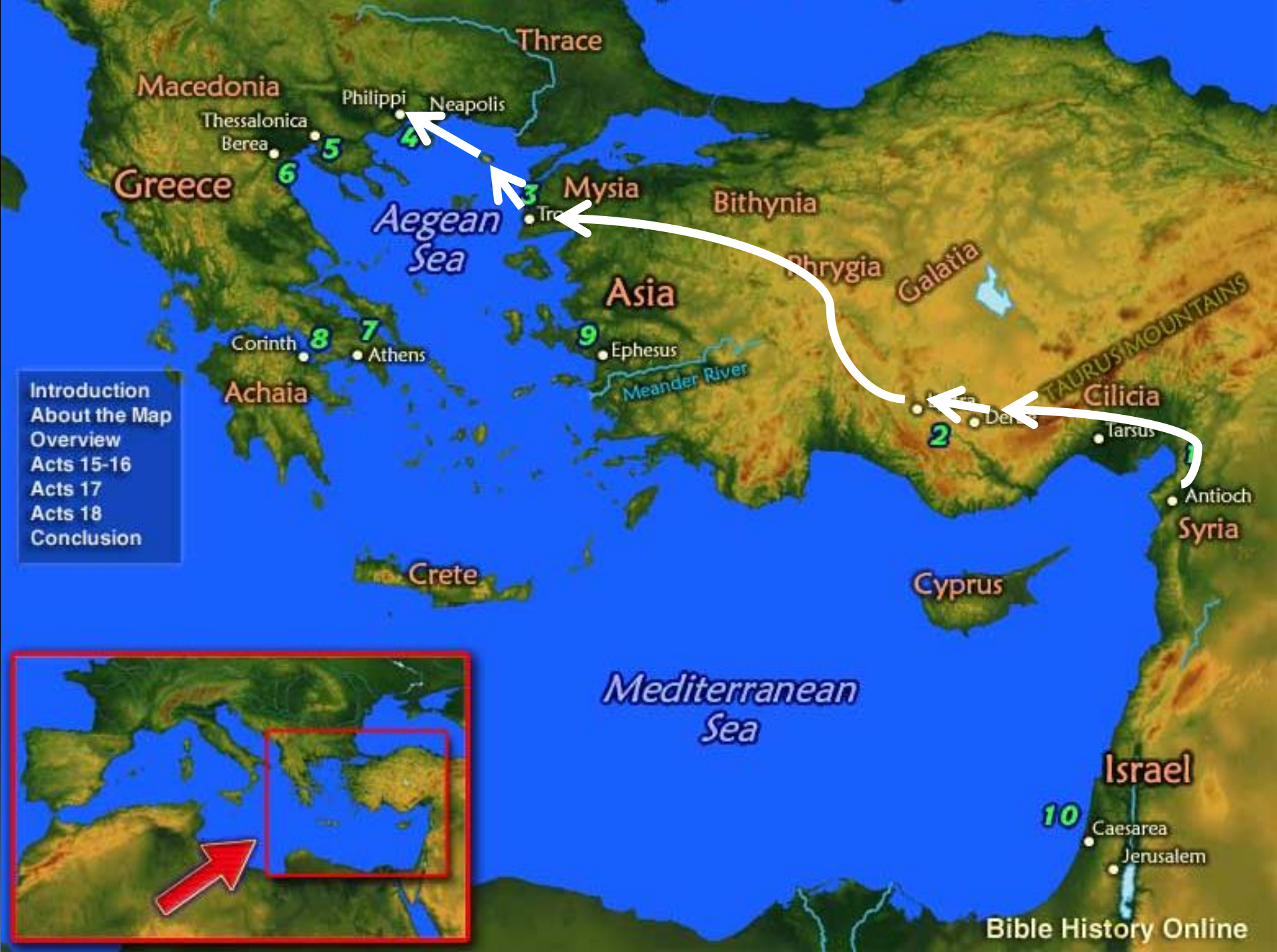

 - People may choose (Matthew 13:13 – 15)
 - God shows no partiality (Acts 10:34)

 - Believe (Acts 16:31; John 3:16; 8:24)
 - Repent (Acts 16:33; 17:30)
 - Be baptized (Acts 16:15, 33 – 34)
