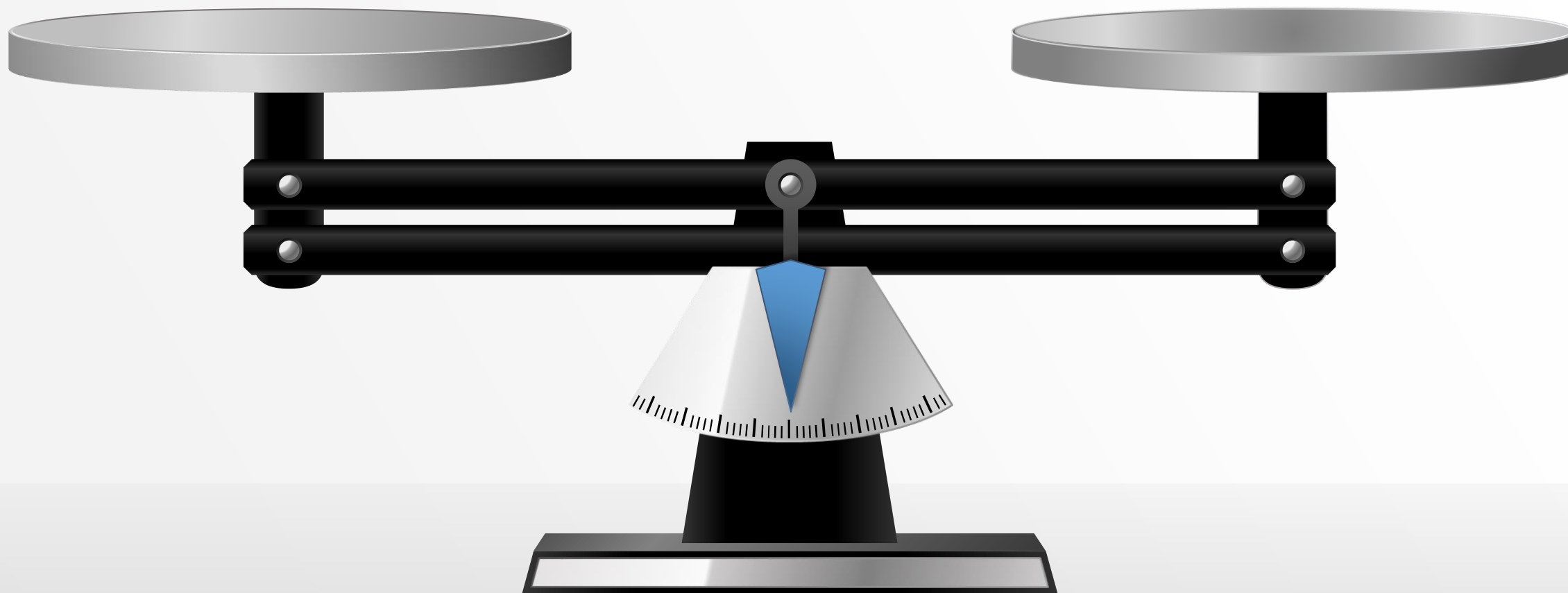

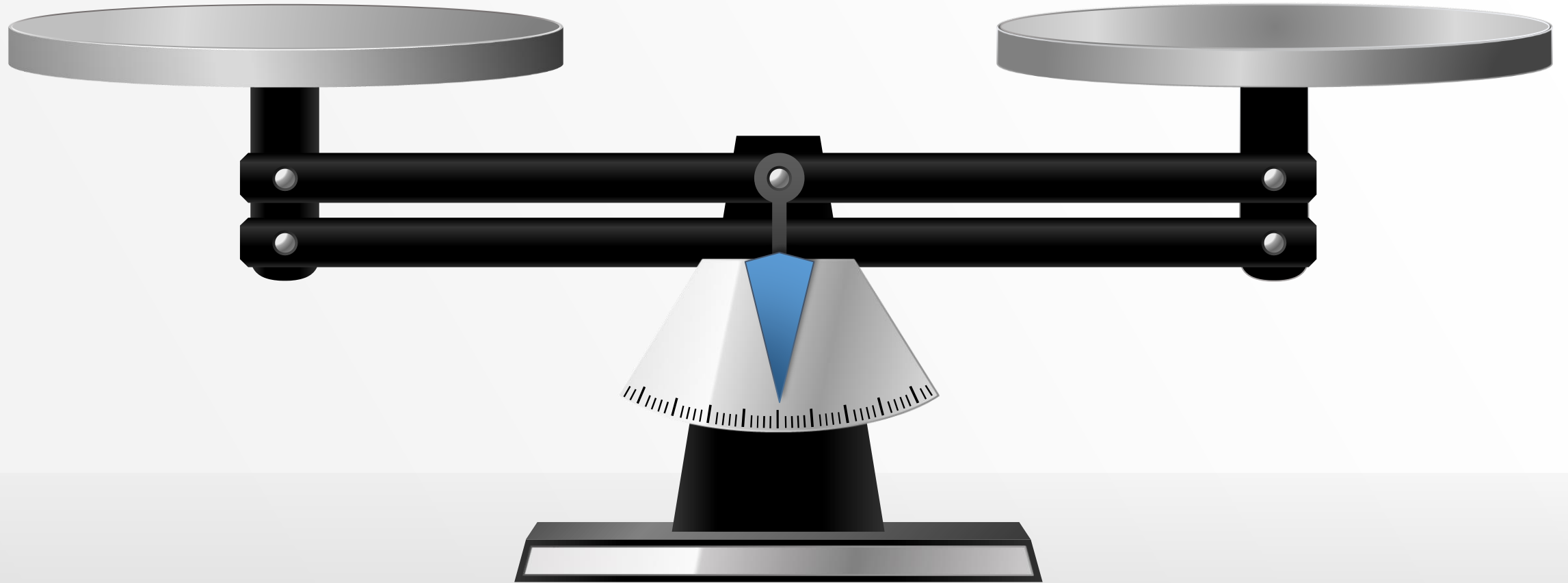

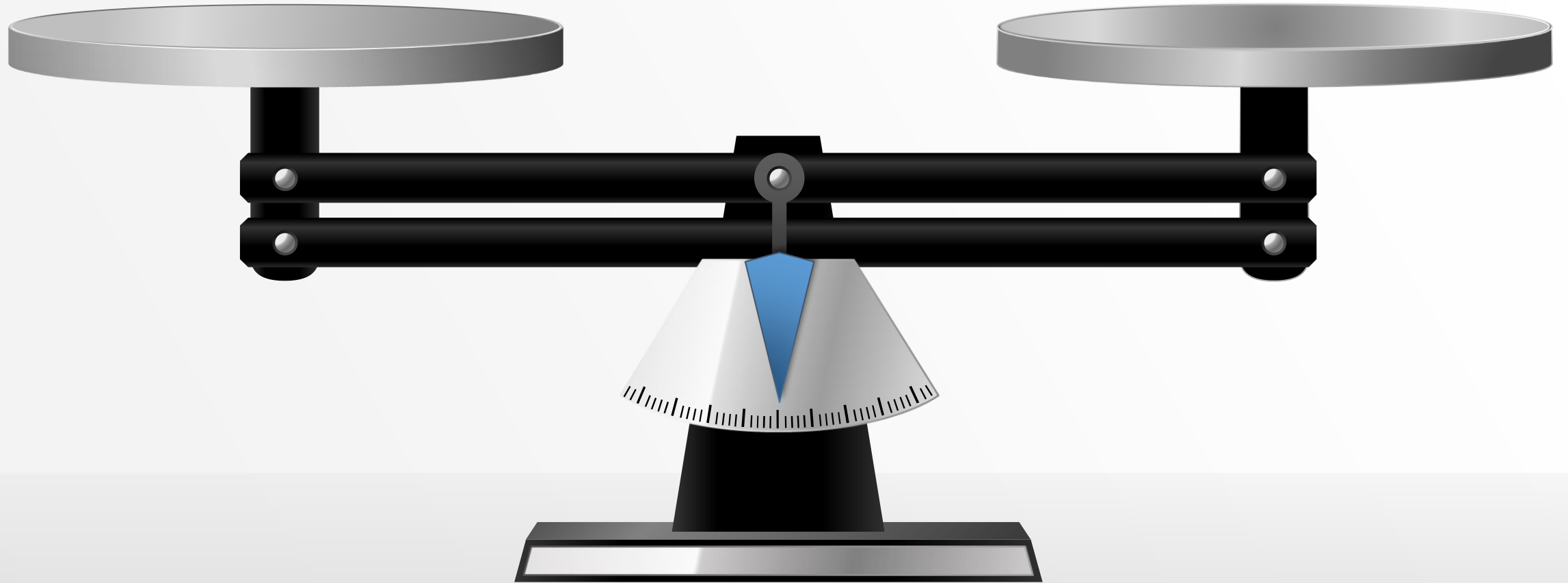

## Loving and Obeying Like Jesus

- (Heb. 5:7 – 9) “During the days of Jesus' life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with fervent cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his **reverent submission**. 8 Son though he was, he **learned obedience** from what he suffered 9 and, once made perfect, he became the **source of eternal salvation for all who obey him**”

## Law and Love Combining

- **Grace and mercy understood is holiness desired.**
- We serve Christ “who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are **zealous for good works**” (Titus 2:14).
- We serve and obey not out of **Dread to Earn** His favor, but **out of Delight** because we have it in Christ. (Romans 5:1)

## Worship – Sacrifice – Feast in the Wilderness

Exodus 3:18 “They will pay heed to what you say; and you with the elders of Israel will come to the king of Egypt and you will say to him, 'The LORD, the God of the Hebrews, has met with us. So now, please, let us go a three days' journey into the wilderness, that **we may sacrifice** to the LORD our God.”

Seven times Moses says to Pharaoh; “Let my people go that they may serve me, that they may make a feast (worship) to me in the wilderness” (Ex. 5:1; 7:16; 8:1, 20; 9:1, 13; 10:3).

## God Serves them a Feast

---


- He meets their needs not with the feast they expect, but the **feast they need.**
- “Man shall not live by bread alone – but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.” (Deut. 8:3; Matt. 4:4)

## The Law that Protects

- Deut. 6:24 – 25 "So the LORD commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God for our good always and **for our survival**, as *it is* today. "It will be **righteousness** for us if we are careful to observe all this commandment before the LORD our God, just as He commanded us."
- For the believer, the law becomes a means of grace.
